

# Do I Qualify?



Pick up a CHAS application form at any Community Centre, Public Hospital or Polyclinic or visit [www.chas.sg](http://www.chas.sg) to download the form.

Only one application form per household is needed. All eligible members in your household will receive a Health Assist card if your application is successful.

Once you receive your card, simply bring it with you, along with your NRIC, on your next visit to a participating clinic. CHAS clinics can be easily identified by the CHAS sticker displayed.

## To qualify for CHAS, you must:

- Be a Singapore Citizen
- Be 40 years old and above OR disabled\* AND
- have a per capita household monthly income of \$1,500 and below OR live in a residence with an Annual Value (AV)\* of not more than \$13,000 if your household has no income

## How is per capita household monthly income calculated?

Total household income divided by the total number of members in the household.

For example:

## Who is considered my household?

All related family members (by blood or marriage) living in the same residential address as reflected on their NRIC(s) and/ or birth certificate(s).

There are two types of Health Assist cards:

HEALTHASSIST	HEALTHASSIST
For those with per capita household monthly income of \$900 and below <b>or</b> households with no income and live in a residence with Annual Value of \$13,000 and below	For those with per capita household monthly income above \$900 but less than or equal to \$1,500
<b>Subsidies for common illnesses</b>	<b>Not Applicable</b>
Up to \$18.50 per visit	<b>Not Applicable</b>
<b>Subsidies for chronic conditions</b>	<b>Subsidies for dental services</b>
Up to \$80 per visit and up to \$480 per year	Up to \$50 per visit and up to \$300 per year
<b>Subsidies for dental services</b>	<b>Subsidies for chronic conditions</b>
Up to \$256.50 per procedure per year	Up to \$170.50 per procedure per year for <b>selected</b> procedures

Depending on what the clinic charges you, what you pay = total bill size - subsidies
